- Great work at the structure fire in North Canaan. We were upgraded from RIT to a full response and were asked to take over operations upon arrival. Everyone worked well with mutual aid on a stubborn fire of aggressive overhaul.
- Cold Water Rescue Class in Norfolk w/CFA: March 7&8. Still a few seats open.
- Penguin Plunge in Winsted was cancelled due to low enrollments
- Aquarian Water has finalized the hydrant flow rates in town and are sending us the report. Will be included in our preplans/spotted dog
- AFG Regional Radio Grant update: compiled list of financial difficulties for each town to show need, each Towns debt, upcoming town projects, declining school enrollment with

same budget, sewer district upgrades, bridge replacement, etc. Winsted has similar needs with also referencing the town manager stealing millions. Let me know if you'd like to read it.

- Officers and Ambulance are updating the FD 1st responder auto dispatch list to keep current with changes over the years by EMD. Supplemental 1st responder program started in July 2014.
- Officers are reviewing automatic Mutual Aid responses on fire dispatches to recognize new resources available and new codes rolling out when EFD v7 goes live this year.

- Corona Virus: No cases in CT as of today and taking basic precautions is all that's needed right now. There is a meeting this week at the Torrington area health to discuss resources and the state shifting to a pandemic planning phase for when the virus spreads to the U.S. For now treat it like the flu, wash hands, wear gloves, avoid direct skin to skin and mask the patient if there's mention of recent international travel. There are N95 masks in the Nitrile glove box on S20, along with hand sanitizer gel, Lysol spray and Lysol wipes in the medical compartment on S20 and in the cab on E40. People overreacting country wide have depleted supplies of masks and gowns for those who actually need it.
