- -Damage to Brush 50 from tree falling onto it. Windshield, Hood, Lightbar, Mirror, Spotlight dome being repaired, insurance/town claim started.
- -Squad, & U70 can got for annual service after B50 is repaired (this week or next)
- -Cold Water Rescue Class in Norfolk w/CFA: March 7&8. We get 4 free seats. \$90/pp for all other participants/mutual aid
- -Justin & Casey FF1 graduation. Monday, Jan 13th 7p at the fire school
- -Regional Radio AFG Grant update:
 - The group decided on Dual band, VHF & 7/800Mhz radios.
 - Norfolk VFD allotment is (27) portables \$162,000 & (9) mobiles \$52,000.
 - Radios will equip all 8 FD officers, 2 in each apparatus, the FM, & EMD, & 5 for the EM Trailer.
 - \$214,000 total with a 5% cost share (\$10,700) of radios to Norfolk FD plus the grant writer fee of \$200.
 - FD is responsible for installation costs.
 - Grant writer is Amalio Jusino, president of ERC Emergency Response Consulting. His firm wrote the regional LUCAS Grant for us.
 - Participants in the regional grant are Norfolk FD, Norfolk EMS, Winsted FD, Winchester FD. Barkhamsted FD & New Hartford FD are submitting a separate grant on their own behalf.

- -Hartford Healthcare is petitioning the state OEMS to allow them to staff a supplemental Paramedic in Winsted & Torrington to increase the ALS responses when Medic 6 is on another call.
- -Connecticut passed a law beginning January 1st
