- -4" hose from Northfield is here and in service. Actually got (5) 30'footers
- -DEEP \$2500 50/50 grant submitted for low flow strainers and valves to increase our GPM delivery for Tanker shuttles.
- -Thanks for the crews for the midnight calls. Good reminder for all of us that alarms can be actual fire when we get there.
- -Fire Reporting software update. Have pricing from 7 vendors. Alpine Software/RedAlert has the most affordable platform that meets our needs. 3-year Package deal with Colebrook and Barkhamsted. we currently pay \$1800 for ER and \$400 for Spotted dog (both of which are being Sunsetted by ESO). Red alert is \$723 more at \$2,923.05/yr. +5% annual increase. Motion to pursue.
- -Due to ESO taking over, Spotted Dog is being turned off between June 30th and August 31st. LCD is moving to launch the app "FireTek" countywide for everyone. Stay tuned for the official release mid-July. There will be a training for everyone on its use.
- -LCD Incident/Status boards replacing spotted dog on the FD monitors. Your phones and truck I Pads will show who's coming via FireTek
- -Patrick from CTS was up last week and updated the firmware in several radios that were at the station. He also turned on our talk group and started reconfiguring our Norfolk zones to include the new LCD "Response" channel. He'll be back for the officer radios TBA.
