The meeting was called to order by Mr. H. H. Bridgman who briefly stated the purpose of the meeting.

Mr. R. L. Crissey was chosen moderator and E. H. Johnson clerk.

Voted: - Than a volunteer fire company be formed.

After some discussion as to the member and duties of officers Mr. Edmund Brown was unanimously elected Chief.

Motion was made and carried that a committee of three, including the chief, be appointed by the chair to recommend candidates for the positions of first and second assistants to the Chief.

The Moderator appointed W. O'Connor and James P. Levi.

The committee reported the names of William O'Connor for first assistant and Warren C. Corbally for second assistant.

Voted:- To accept the committees report.

Voted:- Than any other officers found to be needed should be appointed by the chief and assistants.

Voted:- Than a committee of four be appointed by the chair to look up the matter of a suitable building and report on a future meeting.

The moderator appointed H.H. Bridgman, H.E. Stevens, M.E. Snow, and M.H. Mulville.

Voted:- Than the matter of a system of alarms be left to the officers of the company for settlement.
