ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

BE IT KNOWN, That we, the subscribers, do hereby associate ourselves as a body politic and corporate, pursuant to the statute laws of the State of Connecticut regulating the formation and organization of corporations without capital stock, and the following are our articles of association:-

Article 1. The name of said corporation shall be The Norfolk Volunteer Fire Department, Incorporated.

Article 2. The purposes for which said corporation is formed are the following, to wit:-

To establish and maintain in the town of Norfolk Litchfield County, Connecticut, a Fire Department for the purpose of extinguishing fires, to hold real estate and personal property and to do any and all things necessary, proper and incidental, for the accomplishment of said purpose.

Article 3. The said corporation is located in the Town of Norfolk, County of Litchfield and State of Connecticut.
